

An invitation.....

The reinterment of King Richard III in Leicester has captured the attention of the entire world. As not every member can attend the events in Leicester, we have organized our own commemoration of King Richard for the members (and friends) local to Toronto.

On **Sunday, March 22nd**, at **4 p.m.** there will be an Evensong service at **St. Peter's Anglican Church in Erindale** to commemorate the discovery and reinterment of King Richard. While not an exact reproduction of the evensong service conducted in Leicester (that is a closely guarded secret), we will duly honour the king with a service he would have recognized. This service will be followed by a pub dinner at **5:30 p.m.** at Blarney's Gate Irish Pub in Mississauga. (You'll remember that Richard's father, Richard Duke of York, was Lord Lieutenant of Ireland from 1445 to 1450, and Earl of Ulster).
